

## Research Student Admission information

### (1) Before application

- Applicants should obtain consent from the professor with whom you wish to pursue your research.
- Contact the professor by yourself.

### (2) Application Requirements

- Graduates of university medical studies
- Individuals deemed by a faculty meeting to be at the same academic level or above, as previously mentioned

### (3) Deadline for Application

- 25<sup>th</sup> of the month before last when you wish to enroll (strictly enforced)
- Place for application: Student Services Office (KYOMU-KAKARI)
- Office hour: 9:00-12:00 and 13:00-16:45 (excluding weekends and holidays)
  
- Admission date: the first of every month

### (4) Application Process

- Please obtain application materials and submit applications through the laboratory you are accepted.

### (5) Entrance Examination fee

- \*Credit cards are not accepted. Entrance Examination fee payment slip is included in the Application guideline. Please be prepared to pay in yen.

### (6) Screening

- Admission will be reviewed at the faculty meeting.

### (8) Expenses

- Students can apply for scholarships after admission; however, many scholarships are not available to research students. Scholarship applicants will not necessarily receive scholarship funds; therefore, it is recommended that students come to Japan with sufficient

funds for tuition fees and living expenses.

(9)Notes:

- The certificates must be in English.
- The enrollment period is usually one year (until March 31<sup>st</sup> of the following year); however, if it is deemed necessary for research, this period can be extended.
- The enrollment period for mid-term transfers is also until the end of that year (March 31).

(10)Scholarship Information

-Scholarships for international students

Private scholarship foundations provide scholarships to international students in Japan, however, most of those scholarships can be applied after students enter Japanese universities. So it may be difficult to obtain a scholarship for your first year in Japan.

If you have financial difficulties please try Japanese Government Scholarship.

-Japanese Government Scholarship (MEXT Scholarship)

Japanese Government Scholarship (MEXT Scholarship) is offered by Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science, and Technology (MEXT) to international students who wish to study at Japanese universities.

This scholarship covers fees for matriculation, tuition and entrance examinations at a university as well as a flight ticket to Japan.

### (1)出願に先立って

- ・志願者は、志望する研究室の教授に受け入れの内諾を得ておくこと。
- ・研究室へは自分で連絡すること。

### (2)出願資格

- ・大学において医学を修め卒業した者
- ・教授会において前項と同等以上の学力があると認められた者

### (3)出願期限

- ・入学希望日の前々月の25日（期限厳守）
- ・受付場所：医学系研究科総務課教務係
- ・受付時間：9:00-12:00、13:00-16:45（土日祝日を除く）
- ・入学日：各月1日付け

### (4)出願手続き等

- ・受入予定の研究室を通して、出願書類を入手してください。また出願についても受入予定の研究室を通して行ってください。

### (5)検定料

・奨学金は、すべて入学後に申し込むことができますが、研究生が対象の奨学金は多くありません。また、必ず受給できるとは限りませんので、授業料、生活費などに余裕を持って来日することをおすすめします。

### (9)注意事項

- ・出願時に提出する証明書は、英文のものが必須です。
- ・在学期間は原則として1年（年度末3月31日まで）ですが、研究上必要と認められたときは、在学期間の延長を許可します。
- ・年度途中の入学の場合も、在学期間は当該年度の終わり（3月31日）までです。
