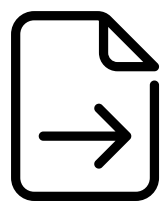

## What is CAMPUS Asia Alumni Workshop?



The CAMPUS Asia Alumni Workshop (CAAW), organized by the Trilateral Cooperation Secretariat (TCS), is a platform that brings together CAMPUS Asia/CAMPUS Asia Plus alumni and current students from China, Japan, the Republic of Korea, and ASEAN partner countries.

The workshop aims to foster dialogue, share experiences, and explore how youth can contribute to trilateral and regional cooperation, promote people-to-people exchange, and support the future development of the CAMPUS Asia Program.

## What will you experience in the program?



- **Participate in group discussions and team-based presentations** on practical ideas to strengthen the CAMPUS Asia Program and regional cooperation
- **Join career talks** featuring diverse career paths across different fields
- **Engage in a joint session with the Young Scholars Forum (YSF)** and exchange ideas with young scholars on the future of trilateral and regional cooperation
- **Build connections across the CAMPUS Asia community and beyond**, including participants, young scholars, and professionals
- **Experience a site visit or cultural activity**

## Eligibility



The TCS is recruiting 30 CAMPUS Asia/CAMPUS Asia Plus alumni and current students from the People's Republic of China, Japan, the Republic of Korea, and ASEAN member states. Applicants should meet the minimum requirements as follows:

- **Education:** Applicants must be CAMPUS Asia/CAMPUS Asia Plus alumni or current students of the Program who studied and have studied as exchange students for a minimum of one regular academic semester (excluding summer and winter programs) in at least one of the CJK countries under the CAMPUS Asia/CAMPUS Asia Plus Program.
- **Nationality:** Applicants must hold the nationality of the People's Republic of China, Japan, the Republic of Korea, or an ASEAN member state.
- **Residence:** Applicants must currently be studying or residing in the People's Republic of China, Japan, or the Republic of Korea.
- **Language:** Proficiency in English is required.
- **Interest:** Applicants should demonstrate a strong interest in Northeast Asian affairs, particularly in trilateral cooperation and Trilateral+X\* cooperation, and a willingness to engage in multilateral discussions.

\***Trilateral+X** refers to cooperation between China, Japan, and the Republic of Korea with additional partner countries, including ASEAN member states, on shared regional and global issues.

We welcome applications from diverse backgrounds, including alumni or current students of different consortiums, to build a vibrant and cross-consortium community.

## Administrative Arrangements



TCS will cover the following expenses for participants:

- International airfare
- Partial local transportation in Busan
- Basic insurance
- Accommodation
- Meals during the event
- Program-related activities

Participants should cover the following expenses:

- Visa application fees
- Any personal expenses incurred inside and outside the official program
- Local transportation outside Busan

\*If the number of applicants exceeds capacity, TCS will review the submissions and shortlist candidates through document screening.
